25,000 British Muslims make the annual pilgrimage to Mecca, but thousands more will see their dreams shattered by fraudsters. To make matters worse only 3% then report the crime.



Protect yourself and your loved ones from criminals by:

- ✓ Doing your research – don't book without doing online checks on your travel company. Go to [www.hajjinformation.com](http://www.hajjinformation.com)
- ✓ Make sure your travel company is a member of a recognised trade association such as ABTA
- ✓ Get everything in writing – establish an auditable paper trail and keep records of financial transactions
- ✓ Do not pay the travel company by cash or direct bank transfer into an individual's account
